Our Mission

Empowering Pacific Islander students to navigate their academic, professional, and personal journeys with confidence and cultural pride — through advocacy, professional development, and community engagement.

The Need

PI students in higher education are often underserved and lack culturally competent support systems to help them thrive academically and personally.

Our Approach

Five strategic programs: Individual Development Plans, Professional Development Workshops, Hui 'Ohana, Pā'ina Student Dinners, and Service Learning Trips.

REAL PROGRAM COSTS

Development Plan	Hui 'Ohana	Pā'ina Student Dinner	Pago Pago & Apia Service Learning Trip
\$300 per student (2-4 yr journey)	\$10,000 each (Feb & Aug annually)	\$1,000 each (Oct/Nov & May/Jun)	\$60,000 total May 2027 (16 students + 4 chaperones)

ONE-TIME GIVING OPPORTUNITIES

Believer \$300

Fund 1 complete Individual Development Plan — a personalized roadmap guiding one student from enrollment through graduation.

Pā'ina Sponsor \$1,000

Sponsor one students-only dinner in our home — a safe, nourishing space for Pacific Islander students to simply be themselves. Fall (Oct/Nov) or spring (May/Jun).

Builder \$1,875

Sponsor 1 complete Professional Development Workshop — one session for the entire student cohort.

Mentor \$10,000

Sponsor 1 Hui 'Ohana — a grand cultural gathering for 60-90 Pacific Islander students, families, and community. Held twice yearly (Feb & Aug).

Village Partner \$60,000

Fund the Pago Pago and Apia Service Learning Trip — our annual Service Learning Trip — an immersive cultural experience reconnecting 16 students with their roots in American Samoa, May 2027. Covers all 20 participants (16 students + 4 chaperones).
